<i>Picea omorika</i>	Serbian Spruce
<i>Picea orientalis</i>	Oriental Spruce
<i>Pinus cembra</i>	Swiss Stone Pine
<i>Pinus flexilis</i>	Limber Pine
<i>Pinus koraiensis</i>	Korean Pine
<i>Pinus rigida</i>	Pitch Pine
